And, as the year came to a close, we put finishing touches on the Welcome Them Home sanctuary expansion, a multi-year, \$20 million labor of love to expand the sanctuary to welcome all chimpanzees currently eligible to retire to Chimp Haven.

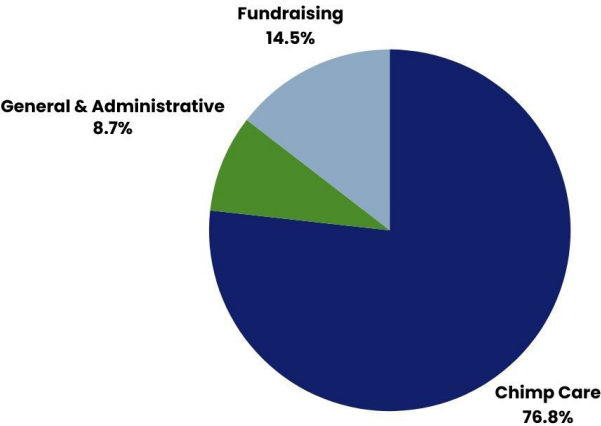
