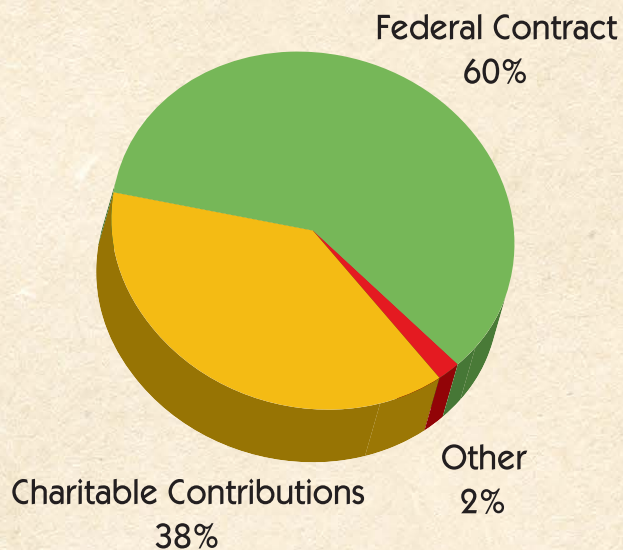

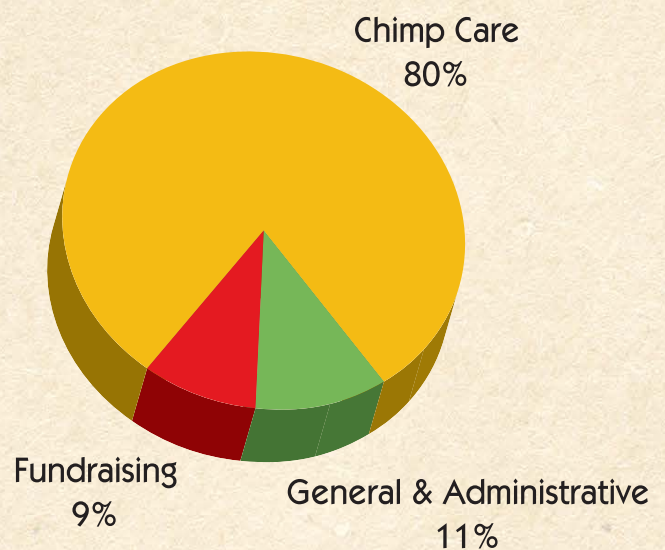

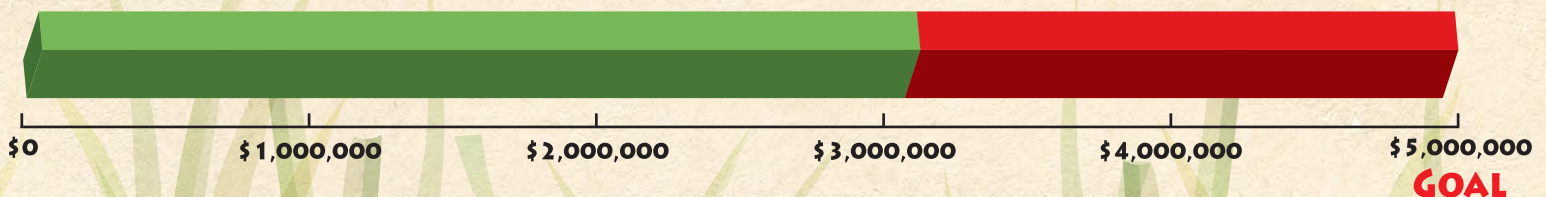

Offering a Little TLC



When the Road to Chimp Haven capital campaign was launched at the end of 2012, many organizations and individuals stepped up as champions for the chimpanzees who would soon call Chimp Haven their forever home. Of those champions, the American Anti-Vivisection Society, became a superhero for the seven New Iberia Research Center youngsters – Jimmy, Quilla, Arden, Diane, Mason, Onyx and Riley – committing to providing for their lifetime care.

“We are very excited to partner with Chimp Haven to ensure that these young chimpanzees will have complete security for the rest of their lives,” AAVS President Sue Leary said. “The heart-wrenching story of chimpanzees in research is coming to an end and these little boys and girls represent the hope for the future.”

To help with this ambitious undertaking, AAVS launched Total Lifetime Care (TLC) for Chimps, an ongoing campaign that allows individuals to contribute to the care of these retired youngsters. In December, the organization presented Chimp Haven with its first check for \$38,647.

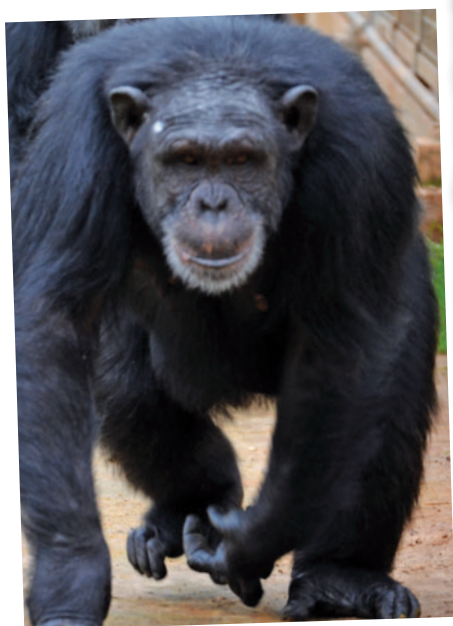
- Crawfish vendor **Shaver's Catering** and **Lilah's Bakery** will be onsite with great food options.

Event Entry Fees: Adults – \$6; Children (6-12) – \$3; Children (5 and under) – Free.

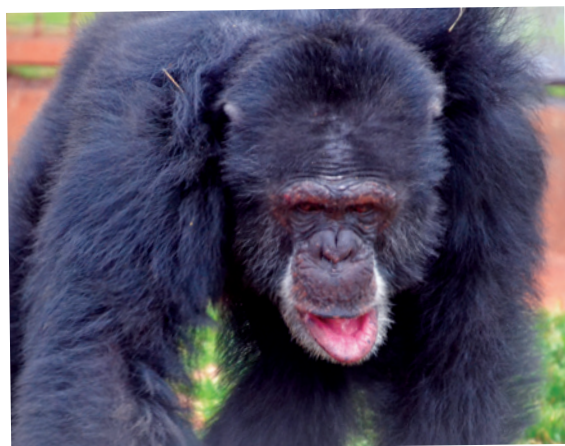

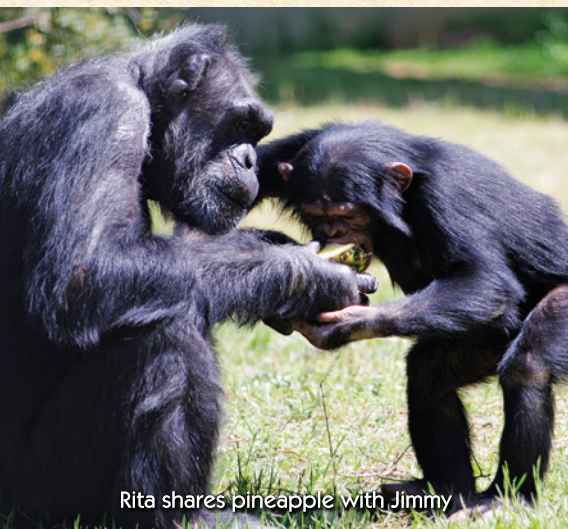

Staff Spotlight

With more than 20 years of animal experience, Dr. Corrine Brown, has a vast knowledge of small animal and primate medicine. She earned a Bachelor of Science degree at the University of Nebraska - Lincoln and a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree at Ohio State University. While at Omaha's Henry Doorly Zoo, she was responsible for the veterinary care of 4,000 animals representing several hundred species. She also made significant discoveries in reproductive physiology in great apes.

Dr. Brown accepted the veterinarian position at Alaska Raptor Center in 1999. There she rehabilitated 200 bald eagles every year and established Alaska Wildlife and Wildfowl Conservation, a small business that took her to some of the most remote corners of Alaska to provide veterinary services for wildlife biologists.

Chimp Haven is delighted to have Dr. Brown, a longtime friend and relief veterinarian of the sanctuary, as an official member of its veterinary staff and looks forward to the great contributions she will make to the care of its residents.
