All of us at Chimp Haven are so grateful for your continued support in providing nearly 300 former research chimps with another wonderful year of sanctuary retirement.

This year was a particularly exciting time at Chimp Haven as we received news that all the remaining chimps from the Alamogordo Primate Facility in New Mexico would finally get their chance to transfer to sanctuary.

In the span of just a few months, the team worked tirelessly to prepare for their arrival, and our amazing supporters pledged more than \$5.6 million to fund a building addition that would ensure space for the Alamogordo chimps at the sanctuary long-term.

Soon after the Alamogordo chimps were welcomed home, we were thrilled to give CBS Sunday Morning an inside look at the world's largest chimpanzee retirement community, including some of the ways it's not so different from human retirement (waterfront happy hours, anyone?).

And, amongst all the excitement, we kicked off Chimp Haven's 30th anniversary, a year-long celebration of the dedicated individuals who came together to dream of a better future for chimpanzees. It would have been impossible to predict that today, Chimp Haven would be the world's largest chimpanzee sanctuary, having provided sanctuary to more than 500 former research chimps.

As we look back at an incredible year, I'm more grateful than ever for your partnership and support, which has allowed so many chimpanzees to experience the life they always deserved.

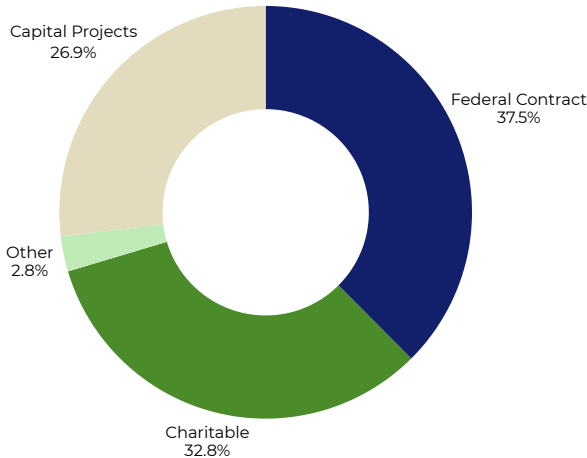

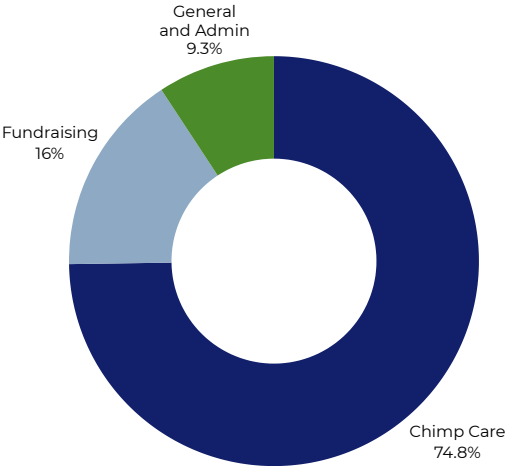
